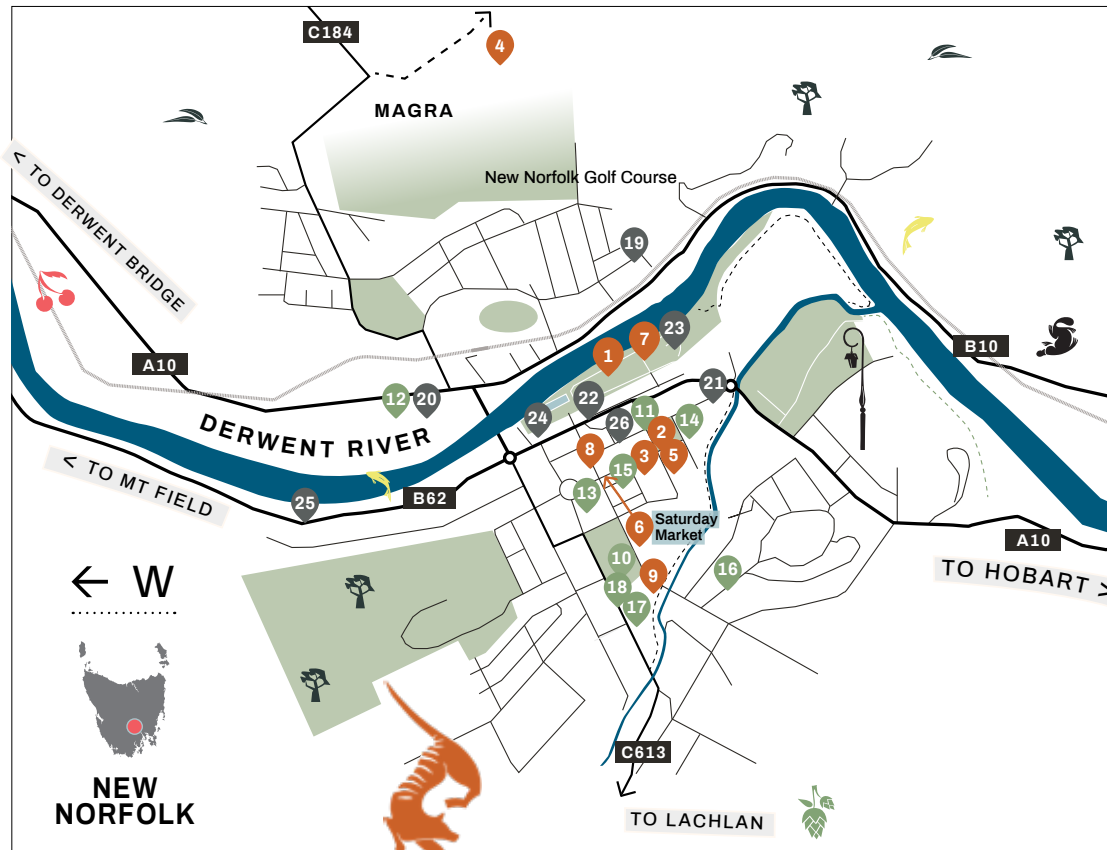


A TOWN OF SURPRISES

Feed the trout at *Salmon Ponds* and *glamp* in style by the banks of the Derwent River. Arrive at a *wine tasting by seaplane*. Walk to three fabulous waterfalls in under three hours. Stroll among the giant trees in the UNESCO World Heritage listed *Styx Valley*.

Hear the Babble and Gossip of the river by the *Possum Shed Cafe*. Soak in a *Bush bath* under the stars at *Left of Field Campground*. Find your treasure at the *New Norfolk Market* on Saturday. Get your hands dirty at *Leap and Wander Pottery*.

Pick your own raspberries at *Westerway*. *Paddle a kayak* with the Platypus and sample our hemisphere's longest mountain bike trails.

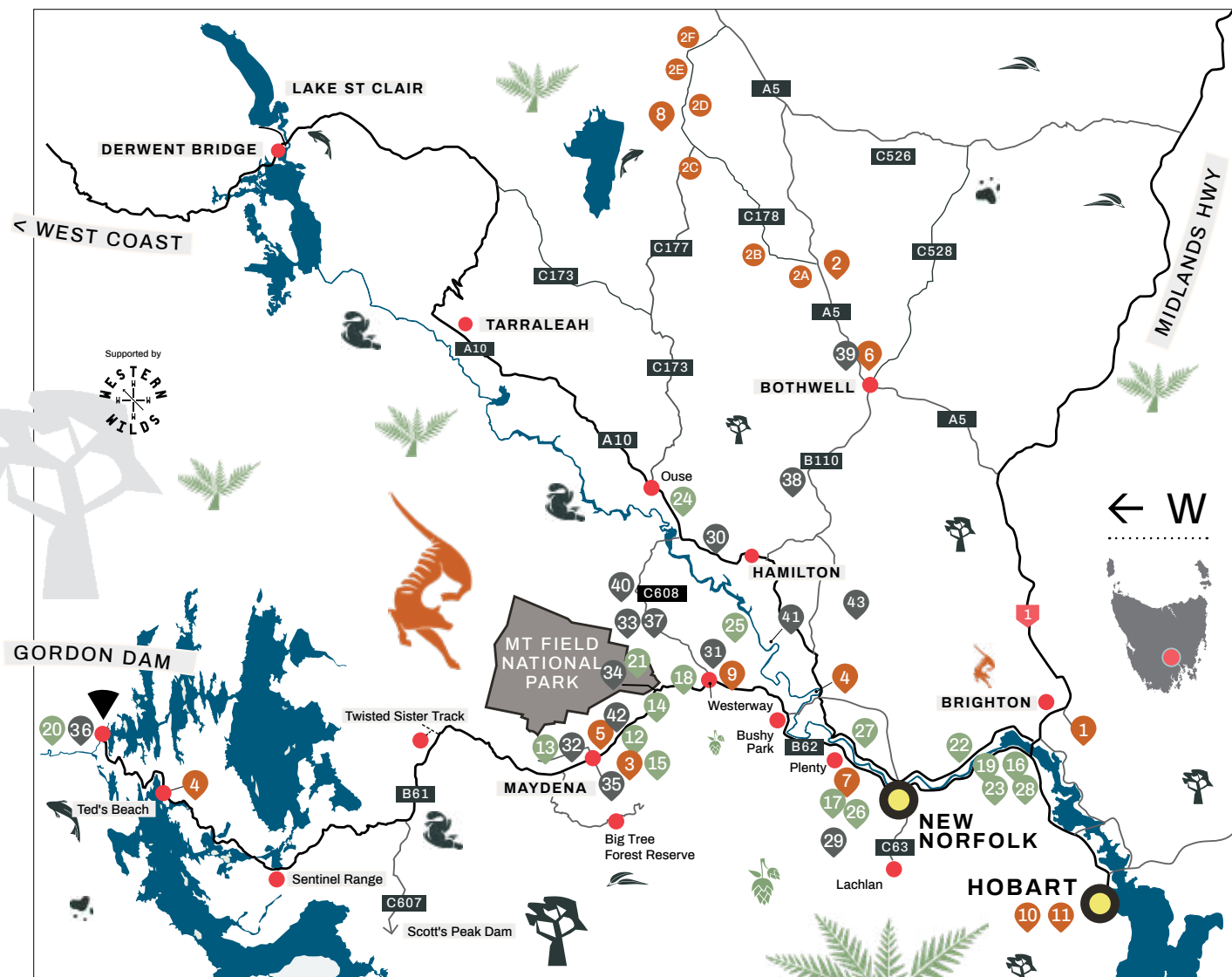
Catch the \$2,000 trout in Lake Pedder.
